Our SBHC doesn't take the place of your family's physician or dentist, but instead works as an additional service to enhance the care of the student in a convenient location. Your physician will always be informed of any treatment or problems. If you don't have a physician or insurance, we will work with you to determine what options are available. ***Nobody will be turned away because of an inability to pay and parents will always be contacted prior to most treatments.***
